



What is GOD Like?

Dear Seeker,

How can we know what God is like? The only way we can know what God is like is for God to tell us or show us what He is like. Long, long ago, God talked with people and told them what He was like.

God talked to many different men at different times. They wrote down the words that God told them to write. They made a big book out of many small books. We call this big book "the Bible."

One of the men God talked to was a man named Jeremiah. God told Jeremiah, "Write in a book for yourself all the words that I have spoken to you" (Jeremiah 30:2). Jeremiah obeyed God. He wrote God's Word in a book. This book is in the Bible. We call it "the Book of Jeremiah."

Every book in the Bible was written this way. The Bible says, "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God..." (2 Timothy 3:16). This means that every book in the Bible came from God.

Though the Bible was written many, many years ago, God took care of it, and we can read it today. God took care of it because He wanted to talk to you and me through the Bible.

God speaks to us through the Bible. It tells us the truth about God. It tells us the truth about

ourselves. It tells us the truth about our enemy, Satan. It tells us the truth about sin. It tells us the truth about how we can be saved.

TRUTH 1: God is a PERSONAL BEING

The Bible tells us that there is only one God. In the Bible, God says, "I am the LORD, and there is no other; There is no God besides Me" (Isaiah 45:5).

Some people think that there are many gods. But in the Bible, God tells us there is only one true and living God. He says, "...For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me" (Isaiah 46:9).

God is a living Personal Being who sees and knows all things. He knows and loves every person. He can help us. God wants us to know Him and love Him. When we know God and love Him, we will be truly happy.



TRuth 2: God ts SPIRIT

Although God is a Personal Being, we cannot see Him. The reason we cannot see God is that God is Spirit. We cannot see a spirit.

When God made the first man, Adam, God gave him a spirit and a body. Every person has a spirit and a body. Your spirit lives in your body. Other people can see your body, but they cannot see your spirit.

God is all Spirit. That is why we cannot see Him. Though we cannot see Him, God is the one true and living God. We must not have any gods other than Him. God says, "You shall have no other gods before Me" (Exodus 20:3). We must love the one true God with all our heart.

Truth 3: God to ALMIGHTY

The word "almighty" means "having all power." God has all power in the universe. In the Bible the word "almighty" is never used of anyone but God. He alone is "almighty." He told Abraham, "...I am Almighty God; walk [live] before Me and be blameless [perfect]" (Genesis 17:1).

God is the Creator of the universe. We cannot imagine how large and how great our universe is. It is believed to contain as many huge stars, like our sun, as there are grains of sand on all the beaches of the world!

How did the universe come into being? God spoke it into being! The Bible says, "By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth" (Psalm 33:6). Our God is so great!

GOD created ALL Things

The very first verse in the Bible tells us, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Genesis 1:1).

The word "create" means to make something out of nothing. Only God can do this. God made the sun, and He made the moon. He made all the stars.

God made this earth on which we live. God made the land, and He made the beautiful mountains. He made the rivers, the lakes, and the seas. He made the grass, the trees, and the beautiful flowers. He made the clouds that bring the rain. God was making things beautiful for the first man and the first woman.

God made the birds that fly in the skies. God made many different kinds of birds. He made the eagle with his strong claws, and He made the pretty little redbird. He made the funny-looking pelican, and He made the gentle dove.

God made the fish that swim in the water. He made many different kinds of fish. God made the great whales, and He made the tiny goldfish.

God made the animals. He made many different kinds of animals. He made the lions that roar in the



jungle, and He made the little rabbits. He made the mighty elephants, and He made the frisky squirrels. God made the horses, the cows, the sheep, the goats, and the pigs.

God told the creatures which He had made to "be fruitful and multiply" (Genesis 1:22) after their kind. This meant that every living creature would have babies like itself. Horses have baby horses; birds have baby birds; fish have baby fish. Every living creature has babies like itself.


"For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth...."
